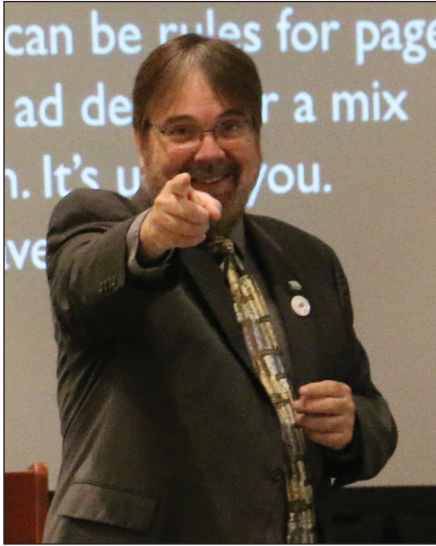

Membership levels



Regular Membership

If you publish twice or more each month, and you've been publishing for six months or more, this is the level for you. Regular memberships are given to publications, not individuals.

Associate Membership

If you publish at least monthly, this is your membership level. Associate memberships are given to publications, not individuals. Benefits include:

- Immediate help and advice from the WNPA staff.
- Access to an attorney in an emergency.
- Access to our annual convention, workshops & webinars.
- Advocacy for your interests, locally, regionally & nationally.



Affiliate Membership

Affiliate membership in WNPA is granted to persons or firms engaged in businesses, professional groups or educational institutions that have a genuine interest in the publishing business. It is also appropriate for those who formerly published or were closely associated with member publications, and who retain an interest in the publishing business. Also freelance writers, photographers and cartoonists are eligible for membership. The benefits include:

Here's how to apply

To qualify for membership, publications must contain original news of substantial community interest. A membership committee judges applications and submits a recommendation to the WNPA Board of Directors for final approval.
